Scholarship Information:

- Scholarship applications are due with Workshop registration forms by June 20th. In order to be considered for a scholarship, students must send \$130 with the completed registration form.
- A scholarship selection committee will review all applications and weigh them against other applications from within the same district. Financial need is the primary basis for selection.
- Applications received by June 20th will receive priority; however, applications received after June 20th will be considered if any scholarships remain.
- 4. All applicants will be notified by July 6th.
- After July 6th the applicants who did not receive a scholarship may either cancel their registration or submit the remaining registration fee.
- 6. All decisions of the committee are final.
- Information submitted on this form will be confidential. Nobody outside of the scholarship committee will view it.

Jerad Manzer Memorial Scholarship

The NASC Volunteer Staff offers a scholarship to honor one of its own, Jerad Manzer. Jerad was a NASC Staff member and former District 4 president who succumbed to heart failure on March 11, 2001. Jerad was an exceptional young man who had just begun to leave his mark on NASC and the world. His endless enthusiasm, dedicated spirit, and positive attitude, which inspired so many, will be greatly missed. In recognition of Jerad's contributions to this organization and to promoting leadership in Nebraska high schools, the NASC Volunteer Staff has created a scholarship to allow others to experience the NASC Summer Leadership Workshops. This is a need-based scholarship available exclusively to District 4 student council members.
