If you're a middle school student looking to become involved as a leader in your school or as a future leader in your high school, JAM is for you. NASC's JAM Workshop will equip you with the skills you need to excel as a leader in your school and community.

Each day, you'll work with other students to learn and apply a variety of leadership skills through activities that are led by the NASC Volunteer Staff. You'll learn principles like goal setting, decision making, time management and meeting facilitation. We use what we call "three-dimensional leadership," which teaches you to excel as an individual, in one-on-one situations and as members and leaders of a group. Most of all, we have fun with each other, learning and engaging in fun activities like a pool party, marshmallow launchers, messy Olympics, outdoor activities and indoor carnival!

You'll also get to connect with students like you from all across the state. You'll share ideas with them, learn what they do in their schools and work together to develop your own leadership skills.
