In order to receive <u>gold</u> recognition, a school must earn 200 points or above In order to receive <u>silver</u> recognition, a school must earn 175-199 points In order to receive <u>bronze</u> recognition, a school must earn 150-174 points. Schools will be awarded an engraved plate at NASC State Convention.

WHEN TO SUBMIT APPLICATION:

The application is to be submitted by October 1. The application is based on the time period from August 15 to August 15, the school year prior to the convention.
