Jerad Manzer Memorial Scholarship

Jerad was a member of our staff and former NASC District 4 president who succumbed to heart failure on March 11, 2001. Jerad was an exceptional young man who had just begun to leave his mark on our organization and the world. His endless enthusiasm, dedicated spirit, and positive attitude, which inspired so many, will be greatly missed. In recognition of Jerad's contributions to this organization and to promoting leadership in Nebraska high schools, the Launch Volunteer Staff has created a scholarship to allow others to experience the NASC Summer Leadership Workshops. This is a need-based scholarship available exclusively to NASC District 4 student council members.
